3. Educational Campaign Update

- a. Bike Rodeo Recap: The Bike Rodeo took place in June 2019.
- b. Event Opportunities
 - i. Farmers Market: Bev Anderson attended the July 3rd Bike to the Market Day and handed out stickers and bicycle safety handbooks.
 - ii. Theatre in the Park: This event takes place in July and August. None of the committee members are available to attend at this time.
 - iii. ECFE in the Park: Melissa is interested in doing the August 21st event. Corrie will provide safety handbooks, bike stickers, and a kids' activity for the event.
- c. Fix-It Station Grant: The CentraCare grant for a Fix It Station has been awarded. Melissa Pribyl ordered a red Fix It Station for Metro Transit to install at the Big Lake Commuter Station. Corrie is working with Metro Transit to put together an agreement that will be brought to Council before installation.
- d. Grant Opportunities: Brad suggested that Corrie look into potential grants through Metro Transit. One idea for potential funding would be to place more wayfinding signage at the commuter station.
- e. Community Education Deadlines: The group discussed Community Education Catalog deadlines. The deadline for the Fall 2019 catalog is July 15th, 2019. The deadline for the Winter/Spring 2019-2020 catalog is November 8th, 2019. The deadline for the Summer 2020 catalog is March 20th, 2020.

- f. Holy Rollers: Janine brought up a recent article titled Holy Rollers in the Star Tribune. This article talked about a group of pastors that bike together. SHIP is hoping to host a bicycle ride to church on September 29th, 2019. She will keep the group updated at the next meeting.
